

- I. Section 301.3. of the Town of Fenner Land Use Regulations is hereby amended to add a new subsection "J", to read as follows:
 - J. Retail stores operated by a resident of the premises and selling at least in part, but not necessarily exclusively, products grown, processed and/or manufactured upon the same premises in a building separate from the residence but containing not more than 2,500 square feet of sales floor area accessible to the public, and not more than 5,000 square feet of total floor area.
- II. This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.


